There will be a complete closure of all lanes eastbound and westbound on NW 199th Street from NW 27th Avenue to the Florida Turnpike Access Road for the deck pour on the pedestrian bridge over NW 199th Street. The complete closure will begin on **Monday, July 8 from 11:00 P.M to 5:00 A.M.** Drivers are advised to follow the detours shown below:

DETOUR DIRECTIONS

Drivers are advised to follow the detours shown below:

To continue on eastbound NW 199th Street drivers can:

- Head southbound on NW 27th Avenue
- Take a left on NW 183rd Street
- Take a left on NW 2nd Avenue
- Take a right to continue on NW 199th Street or take a left to access the Florida Turnpike North/South

To continue on westbound NW 199th Street from NW 199th Street drivers can:

- Take a left on NW 2nd Avenue
- Take a right on NW 183rd Street
- Take a right on NW 27th Avenue

To continue on westbound NW 199th Street from the Florida Turnpike Exit Ramp drivers can:

- Take a left on NW 199th Street
- Take a right on NW 2nd Avenue
- Take a right on NW 183rd Street
- Take a right on NW 27th Avenue
